If you cannot keep your appointment, please call the clinic to reschedule. Appointments more than 15 minutes late are subject to reschedule.

What do applicants need to bring to WIC appointments?

1) Each person applying for WIC benefits:

Each person applying for Women, Infant/Child (WIC), **must be present** at the time of the appointment. A parent, guardian or caretaker of an infant, child or woman under 18 years of age **must be** physically present at the appointment **or the appointment will be rescheduled.** WIC clients must bring their WIC ID folder to the appointment.

2) Proof of identity:

<u>Examples</u> for adult or child applicant and/or parent or guardian/caretaker applicant:

Social Security Card
Birth Certificate
Driver's License or State ID
Immunization record
Passport

Military ID

Examples for newborn infant:

Crib Card
Hospital Birth Verification Letter
Hospital Bracelet
Birth Certificate
Paternity Affidavit
Military ID

Foster ID Card or written document

*Other methods to prove identity are accepted; please contact your WIC representative to inquire about more options.

3) Proof of residency:

Examples:

Current lease Recent utility bill (within 30 days) Bank account statement

No personal mail will be accepted.

New Infant Birth Record with address Letter from shelter or hotel/motel on letterhead Hoosier Healthwise/Medicaid eligibility letter

4) Proof of income:

Includes income documents from everyone in the family who works or has a source of income. **Examples:**

- Paycheck stub(s) for the past 30 days. If paid biweekly, bring two pay stubs; if paid weekly, bring four pay stubs; etc.
- Current Medicaid card
- Prior year's tax return (only if self-employed; must be complete)
- Current Special Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) Letter

- Current Social Security letter
- Current TANF letter
- Letter of child support
- Written statement from employer with contact information - signed and dated
