

Sharps Disposal Program 2024 Annual Report

The Marion County Public Health Department's Sharps Disposal Program was started in 2009 to provide an alternative disposal option for home-generated sharps. Marion County residents can pick up new sharps containers at the three District Health Offices, and then return the full containers to those locations for safe disposal at no cost. The program tracks the number of participants, number of sharps containers collected, and the number of new sharps containers distributed to the public.
